How to Apply 1st - 5th Grades Admission Information & Checklist

There are a number of important steps to follow when applying to an independent school. In order to help you easily navigate this process, we have designed this checklist. Please call us if we can answer questions or assist you in any way.

While most Westland students enter the school as kindergarteners, occasionally, through attrition, there are openings in grades 1 through 5. (The school does not accept new 6th graders, as we want students to spend at least two years at Westland.)

The application process includes a parent tour of the school, a parent interview, a time for your child to visit with a teacher, and receipt of school records from your child's current school.

- Applications may be submitted at any time.
- The Application Fee is \$125 and is due with the application.
- Open Houses: Three morning open houses with campus tours will be held in the fall. Please check our website after July 1 for dates, and then call our office to RSVP.
- Flexible Tuition is available to qualifying families. If you are interested in applying for flexible tuition, please sign and return the enclosed Flexible Tuition form with your application for admission.
- Parent Interview: After receiving your application, we will call to schedule your interview with one of our administrators.
- School Release of Information Form: Please complete, sign, and return with your application for admission. We will send the form to your child's current school and they will send records directly to Westland.
- Student Visit: After your parent interview, we'll schedule your child's visit to Westland on a school day.
- 1st – 5th Grades Admission Acceptance Letters will be mailed on March 17, 2017.

The numbers:

- ❖ We have 130 students in 6 multi-age class groupings kindergarten through 6th grade.
- ❖ There is a head teacher and an associate teacher in each class group of 22 students.
- ❖ Head teachers have an average of 23 years of teaching experience.
- ❖ 20% of our students are children of color.
- ❖ The school day is 8:45–3:00, with early dismissal at 2:30 on Tuesdays.

Who we are:

- ❖ We were founded in 1949 on the developmental and progressive principles of John Dewey and Jean Piaget.
- ❖ Active parent participation is integral to the life of the school.
- ❖ Children become self-motivated, enthusiastic learners through real-world experiences that make learning relevant to them.
- ❖ Our social studies-based approach integrates and connects language arts, math, the visual arts, science, music, woodworking, and print shop. Children participate in specialist classes several times per week.

Our children's rich experience also includes:

- Gardening every week in our organic edible community garden.
- A twice-per-week P.E. program that is non-competitive and stresses cooperation, sportsmanship, individual skills and the rules of the game.
- Frequent field trips that are vital to the social studies units; children recreate and share their experiences through block-building, culminations, artwork and journals.

Flexible Tuition

In support of both our founding values and our school community we are pleased to announce that we will begin using the term Flexible Tuition at Westland.

The flexible tuition model has a different approach to tuition reduction. Rather than focusing on a tuition grant or aid, the focus is on a tuition rate that each family can afford. The change in language and practice conveys our fundamental belief that all families have equal value in our community, regardless of the tuition they pay.

The perception of the traditional financial aid model intimates a one-way street – that the recipients are the sole beneficiaries. The flexible tuition model creates a more accurate and inclusive picture, acknowledging that socioeconomic diversity itself brings value to the entire community. In addition, research demonstrates that diversity benefits all students, from improved critical thinking skills and cognition to a more socially responsible worldview.

Our goal over the course of the next four years is to extend flexible tuition to help some of our families whose incomes fall in the middle range. The flex tuition model will be in place for admissions for the 2017/18 school year. As that will be our first year with this model we are uncertain as to how many families will be applying and therefore uncertain as to the top income level that will be eligible for flexible tuition. Each year, as we move forward, we expect that we will gain a clearer understanding of the income levels that will be eligible for flexible tuition.
